



# TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF “THE SECOND LIFE OF A TREE” ART COMPETITION

## §1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The Organiser of the Competition is **Eko-Okna S.A.**, with its registered office in Kornice, ul. Spacerowa 4, 47-480 Pietrowice Wielkie (hereinafter referred to as the “Organiser”).
2. The Competition is held in the territory of the Republic of Poland and in foreign markets where the Organiser's Commercial Partners operate.
3. The Organiser is the sponsor of the prizes.
4. The Competition is not a game of chance, a raffle, or any other form provided for in the Gambling Act.

## §2. PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION

1. The Competition is addressed to the children (up to 15 years of age) of owners and employees of companies that are active Distributors of Eko-Okna S.A. brand products.
2. Participation in the Competition is voluntary and free of charge.
3. On behalf of minor participants, the submission is made by a statutory representative (parent or legal guardian).

## §3. RULES OF THE COMPETITION AND THE TASK

1. The subject of the Competition is the creation of an original art piece (two-dimensional or three-dimensional) entitled “The Second Life of a Tree”.
2. **Technical requirement:** The artwork must be made using natural elements derived from trees (e.g., bark, twigs, sawdust, wood shavings, leaves, pine cones, moss). The use of binders (glue, string) and auxiliary elements (cardboard base) is permitted; however, natural raw materials must constitute the predominant part of the artwork.
3. Each participant may submit only one entry.
4. Entries must be submitted in a digital format.

## §4. DEADLINES AND SUBMISSIONS

1. The Competition runs from the date of its announcement until **15 June 2026, 23:59**.
2. Submissions should be sent electronically to: [marketing2@ekookna.pl](mailto:marketing2@ekookna.pl)
3. The message body must include:
  - The child's name and age.
  - Your customer code.
4. The results will be announced no later than **22 June 2026** on the Organiser's official website and social media profiles.

## §5. EVALUATION CRITERIA AND PRIZES

1. The entries will be evaluated by the Competition Committee appointed by the Organiser, consisting of employees of the Marketing Department.
2. **Evaluation criteria:** creativity, the extent to which natural raw materials are used, aesthetics of execution, and compliance with the theme.
3. Prizes will be awarded in three age categories:
  - **Category I:** 3–6 years old
  - **Category II:** 7–10 years old
  - **Category III:** 11–15 years old
4. The prizes are in-kind. They cannot be exchanged for a cash equivalent.



## **§6. COPYRIGHT AND PUBLICATION OF IMAGE**

1. Upon submitting the entry, the legal guardian grants the Organiser a free, non-exclusive licence to use the work (artwork) for the purpose of promoting the Competition and the Eko-Okna S.A. brand.
2. The legal guardian consents to the publication of the child's name and age, as well as the Distributor's company name, during the presentation of the competition results.

## **§7. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION (GDPR)**

1. The controller of personal data is Eko-Okna S.A.
2. Personal data (name, surname, age, contact details) are processed exclusively for the purpose of conducting the Competition, selecting the winners, and dispatching the prizes.
3. Data will be stored for the period necessary to carry out the competition and settle the prizes.
4. The participant has the right to access their data, rectify it, and request the cessation of its processing.

## **§8. FINAL PROVISIONS**

1. The Organiser reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions during the competition, provided that this does not worsen the conditions of participation.
2. In matters not covered by these terms and conditions, the Organiser's decision is final.
3. Any complaints regarding the Competition may be submitted via email within 7 days of the announcement of the results.
